### Required:

The remaining fifteen credits will be selected from philosophy courses<sup>1, 2, 3</sup> 15

<sup>1</sup> PHIL 101 and PHIL 120 are disallowed for minor credit if taken after the student has earned nine credits in philosophy.

<sup>2</sup> No more than three credits of PHIL 397 and PHIL 498 are allowed toward the minor.

<sup>3</sup> Upon approval of the department up to six credits from courses other than philosophy may be applied to the minor.
